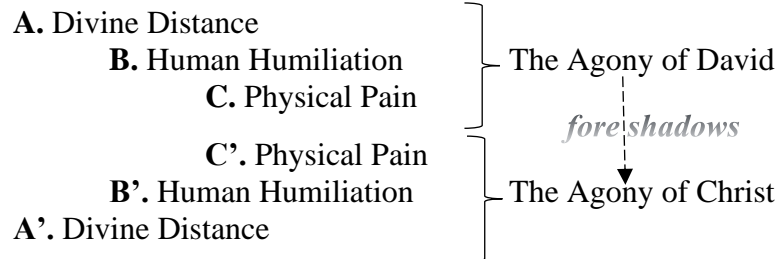
1. Introduction

- A. Like any great work of literature, the Bible contains foreshadowing
- B. The agony and victory of David foreshadows the agony and victory of Christ
- C. Psalm 22 was written about 1,000 years before Christ walked the earth!
