6	Love for God's Word: "May my children grow to find Your Word more precious than pure gold and sweeter than honey from the comb." (Ps 19:10; 1 Thess 5:18). Pray they would think biblically (Rom 12:1-2).	Guidance Counselors
7	Justice: "God, help my children to love justice as You do and act justly in all they do." (Ps 11:7, Mic 6:8) Pray they would hate and avoid evil and get caught when they disobey (Prov 4:14) but that they'd be justified through Jesus Christ (Rom 6:23-24).	Social Workers
8	Mercy: "May my children always be merciful, just as their Father is merciful." (Lk 6:36)	Special Ed Teachers and Support Aides
9	Respect (for self, others, authority): "Father, grant that my children may show proper respect to everyone, as your Word commands." (1 Pet 2:17; Ex 20:12)	Cafeteria Workers
10	Biblical Self-Esteem: "Help my children develop a strong God-esteem that is rooted in the realization that they are God's workmanship." (Eph 2:10)	Janitors
11	Faithfulness: "Let love and faithfulness never leave my children, but bind them around their necks and write them on the tablet of their hearts." (Prov 3:3)	Coaches
12	Courage: "May my children be strong and courageous in their character and in their actions." (Dt 31:6) May their conversations be full of grace and seasoned with salt (Col 4:6).	Secretaries
13	Purity: "Create in them a pure heart, oh God, and let that purity of heart be shown in their actions" (Ps 51:10).	Specialists*
14	Kindness: "Lord may my children always try to be kind to each other and to everyone else" (1 Thess 5:15).	ESL/Foreign Language
15	Generosity: "Grant that my children may be generous and willing to share, and so lay up treasure for themselves as a firm foundation for the coming age." (1 Tim. 6:18-19)	Buildings and Grounds Crew
16	Peace-loving: "Father, let my children make every effort to do what leads to peace" (Rom 14:19). Pray they would forgive as Christ forgave them (Matt 18:21-35).	Library Staff

24	A servant’s heart: “God, please help my children develop servants’ hearts, that they may serve wholeheartedly, as if they were serving the Lord, not men” (Eph 6:7).	Transportation: Drivers, Crossing Guards, etc.
25	Hope: “May the God of hope grant that my children may overflow with hope and hopefulness by the power of the Holy Spirit” (Ro 15:13). Wisdom: Pray they would be wise (Prov 1:7).	Safety: Cyber; Internet; Active shooter; Human Trafficking, etc
26	Willingness and ability to work: “Teach my children, Lord, to value work and to work at it with all their heart, as work for the Lord, nor for men” (Col 3:23).	Clubs: Forensics, Equestrians, Math, etc.
27	Passion for God: “Lord, please instill in my children a soul that ‘followeth hard after thee’ (Ps 63:8 KJV), that clings passionately to you.” Pray they keep their spiritual fervor (Rom 12:11).	New Staff and Students to the area
28	Self-discipline: “Father, I pray that my children may acquire a disciplined and prudent life, doing what is right, just, and fair” (Prov 1:3).	Mental Health Staff
29	Prayerfulness: “Grant, Lord, that my children’s lives may be marked by prayerfulness, that they may learn to pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests” (Eph 6:18; Luke 18:1-8).	Children& Youth Directors & Pastors
30	Gratitude: “Help my children to live lives that are always overflowing with thankfulness and always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ” (Eph 5:20; Col 2:7).	Teachers who are believers
