
# 1 Samuel 14 "Tragedy in Triumph"

# Our Worship

As we gather to worship this morning through faith in Christ, we are entering into conversation with God as He speaks in His Word and is with us by the Spirit. Our worship service has an intentional movement that focuses on the Gospel:

- We begin with our **APPROACH TO GOD**, hearing a call to worship from His word and then responding to Him with songs and prayers of praise.
- We then have a time of **RENEWAL IN CHRIST** in which we confess our sins and hear His promise of forgiveness in His word and through song.
- Assured of His grace, we then listen to **THE WORD OF GOD** as it is preached from our passage for that day, and we all receive the sacrament of communion monthly as a "visible word" from God.
- After hearing the Word preached, we end our service with our **RESPONSE TO GOD.** We give offerings, affirm our faith, pray for needs in the congregation and world, and hear a blessing from God before singing a final praise to Him.

Through it all, God intends to bless us and change us by His grace so that we would go into the world to live for His glory. So let us come in humble faith, ready to hear and respond to our God and Savior.

# **Reflections**

"The kingdom was not Saul's or Jonathan's; it was Yahweh's kingdom. For Jonathan, then, the kingdom was not his to seize, not his to rule, but his to serve...Maybe a tragic life isn't tragic if it's lived in fidelity to what Christ asks of us in the circumstances, he gives us" (Dale Ralph Davis, 1 Samuel, 148).

"We have then these two estimates of Saul, the historical and the covenantal. Both are true. Saul was, looking at the whole picture, a courageous and militarily successful king...Two assessments: both true. But only one matters. One can be a historical success and a covenant failure" (Dale Ralph Davis, 1 Samuel, 149-150).
